

Safety Representatives Refresher Course

This two-day course is designed for health and safety representatives who have been re-elected by the workforce at the end of their two-year term.

Although it is not necessary for representatives to take the five-day training course again, the Act does make provision for this refresher course.

Course Content

- Identify and implement HS Representatives responsibilities in relation to the Offshore Petroleum Act 2006
- Promote and secure the safety and health of people at work
- Consultative mechanisms
- Resolution of issues procedures
- Roles and function of the HS Representative
- Identify, assess and control hazards at work
- Accident investigation principles and techniques
- Work as an effective member of the Safety Committee
- Report writing

- Reinforce the objectives regarding the framework of the legislation relevant to the roles and functions of the representative including any recent amendments to the legislation;
- Review the performance of workplace safety and health consultative mechanisms;
